

Avery Barrel-Aged Series with guest, Bill Brink

No. 1 - Brabant Barrel-Aged Wild Ale

8.65% ABV. 694 cases produced. **Bottled Feb 10, 2009**

Luscious dark ale fermented with two strains of wild yeast (Brettanomyces) then aged for 8 months in Zinfandel barrels. We hope you enjoy sifting through the vast layers of complexity in this mysterious ale.

No. 2 - Sui Generis Barrel-Aged Sour Ale

10.65% ABV. 128 cases produced. **Bottled Sep 18, 2009**

A complex ale, aged and artfully blended from several types of oak barrels, Sui Generis displays a delightful lactic sourness complemented by hints of brett, oak, and acetic. Intricate yet bold, Sui Generis was crafted in the tradition of perennial Tap Room favorites De Vogelbekdieren and Voltron. This brew was drawn from a most unique group of oak barrels: it is a blend of ales from 39% Cabernet Sauvignon barrels, 35% Chardonnay barrels, 13% Port barrels, and 13% Bourbon barrels.

No. 3 - Black Tot Barrel-Aged Imperial Oatmeal Stout

10.08% ABV. 325 cases produced. **Bottled Jan 15, 2010**

An Imperial Oatmeal Stout aged in Gosling's Old Rum Barrels, Black Tot features huge, chewy and endlessly deep flavors of roasted dark malts, sweet rum, espresso and more subtle elements of brown sugar, molasses, and vanilla. Initial sips are bold and intense, but new flavors burst and slide into the milieu as the beer warms, drawing you deeper into the stormy heart of this most dark and tumultuous brew. Black Tot demands to be poured into your favorite glass to be pondered and appreciated.

No. 4 - Dépuceuse Barrel-Aged Wild Ale

9.59% ABV. 463 cases produced. **Bottled Apr 2, 2010**

A 100% brettanomyces fermentation gives this brew lots o' funk throughout, intertwined with pungent elements of sour cherries, delicate aromas of aged wood and a gentle spice imparted the zinfandel barrels. Adventurous and true to the spirit of our Barrel-Aged Series of one-and-done brews, Dépuceuse is a forceful departure from the mindset of traditional beer style and features a harmony of intriguing flavors. Seductive to the core, she lies patiently in the bottle awaiting the day to deflower virgins of the funky flavors of brettanomyces!

No. 7 - Dihos Dactylon Barrel-Aged Sour Ale

10.74% ABV. 248 cases produced. **Bottled Feb 25, 2011**

"Mumbles. Squints. Tie-dye V-necks. Popped collars. Moccasins. Marlin Shorts. Vermont. Was a butcher, then a brewer, now a quitter. We'll miss you man!"

No. 8 - Meretrix Barrel-Aged Sour Ale

9.97% ABV. 83 cases produced. **Bottled Jun 3, 2011**

She's patiently awaited you for two years. Aging gracefully in beautiful Cabernet Sauvignon barrels and accompanied by sour cherries, your Meretrix is now eager to serve. (Brewery release only)

No. 9 - Immitis Barrel-Aged Sour Ale

9.87% ABV. 198 cases produced. **Bottled Aug 17, 2011**

Mercilessly and cruelly sour. A superb blend from 11 of our finest first use Zinfandel barrels. So yes, expect loads of barrel character to compliment the malt and acidity.

No. 12 - Oud Floris Barrel-Aged Sour Ale

9.39% ABV. 252 cases. **Bottled Apr 6, 2012**

Dank u wel for all the help, Gast! It's been very relevant! An expansive Flanders-esque blend as complex, assertive, and infectious as its namesake – although quite a bit more acidic and less injury prone. Proost!

No. 13 - Odio Equum

7.89% ABV. 465 cases produced. **Bottled Sep 14, 2012**

Such a strong and ugly word, but unfortunately true. Our vintner friend just doesn't appreciate the depth and character of the aromas and flavors that Brettanomyces creates like we do. Like you do. But the dude has some seriously fine Cabernet Sauvignon barrels that he shared with us to help create this wondrous sour ale. Our lucky #13 in this series. Aged for 12 months in Cabernet Sauvignon barrels.
